Welcome-to-Scotland dinner begins our group pilgrimage.



It permeates the surrounding landscape with its wonderful Devic consciousness. We'll celebrate the full moon in Sagittarius today.

The Isle of Arran has often been called 'Scotland in miniature' with its remarkable diversity of landscapes and seascapes, beautiful coastlines, rugged mountainous interior, rolling green hills and lush woodlands.



One of the most important prehistoric sites in Scotland lies within a fascinating landscape in which people expended a vast amount of effort creating sites where ritual activity could take place. At the heart of this wider ancient landscape, both physically and spiritually, is Machrie Moor with its magnificent stone circles, standing stones and chambered cairns. It ranks along with Stonehenge and Avebury in England, as well as the stones on the isles of Lewis and Orkney, as one of the best sites for standing stones in the UK. We'll spend ample time engaging with this amazing community of stone beings.

Weather permitting, we have a few options.
Explore Kings Caves, a long but superb forest and coastal walk to a series of mysterious caves steeped in mythology, and offering stunning views.
Or, we'll hike to a lovely faerie glen with spectacular waterfalls and ancient stones.

Officially designated as a UK sacred site, we'll take a short ferry to Holy Isle, its earliest name was Shroin (Gaelic for 'Island of the Water Spirit'). Holy Isle has an ancient spiritual heritage stretching back to the 6th century, and is what the Celtic Bards call a 'thin place' where spiritual realities are powerfully present. It has an ancient healing spring and a hermit cave that we can easily hike to. It was bought by Tibetan Buddhists who run the Center for World Peace and Health. Wildlife is plentiful – ponies, Saanen goats and sheep.

June 2nd, Saturday

Ferry across to explore the beautiful Kilmartin Glen, Valley of the Kings - one of the richest archaeological landscapes in Scotland with the largest concentration of Neolithic and Bronze age remains in Scotland, an ancient sacred site since 6000BC. Stone circles, cairns, ceremonial chambers, cup and ring carvings, and standing stones. We'll climb the powerful Dunnad Hill, where for centuries the Dalriada kings and queens were consecrated as divine bloodline. We'll travel a short distance to Oban, a gorgeous seaside town.
